Obituary

Deneen Nicole Harrison, oldest daughter of Frank Harrison and the late Anna Harrison was born May 20, 1964 in Brooklyn, New York. She moved to Rice, Virginia at a young age. As a child, she had a seeing and hearing impairment that made it difficult to attend regular public school, so she attended the School for the Blind in Stanton, Virginia and a few years later she attended Prince Edward Public School here in Farmville, Virginia until graduation. She eventually moved to Charlottesville, Virginia where she worked for one of the Virginia State work agencies for a number of years until about two years ago. There was a lay-off for some of the workers; she has been looking for work every since.

She confessed to Christ at an early age and joined the Mt. Zion Second Baptist Church of Green Bay, Virginia.

Some of her last words to her father Sunday, May 22, were: "I want to come home when revival starts at Mt. Zion." She attended churches in Charlottesville whenever she could get a ride.

She leaves to cherish her memories: her father, Frank C. Harrison; sister Dwauleka Harrison from Atlanta, Georgia, two brothers; Devendorf N. Harrison (Jade) of Hawaii and Darangi N. Harrison (Mary) of Farmville, Virginia and a host of other relatives and friends.
